CHALLENGE by:

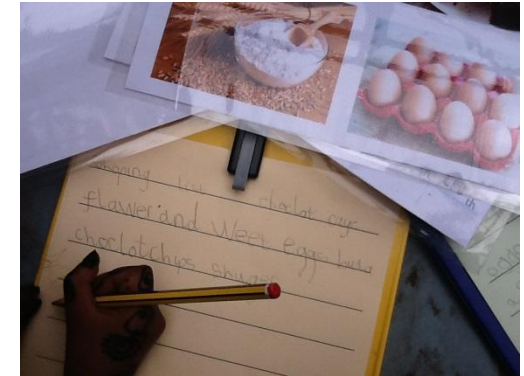
- *promoting a Growth Mindset in all children and adults within the Hawthorn Community
